<sup>\*1</sup> Students must take at least 3 non-accounting business electives in the program. It is strongly recommended that the electives include ACCT 5380 (ethics) and BCOM 5375 (business communications) to meet CPA exam eligibility requirements.

<sup>\*2</sup> Internship (ACCT 5399) may be counted as an accounting elective OR a business elective. You can coordinate an internship with Ms. McGhee, and it may be counted as an accounting class by the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy.

<sup>\*3</sup> The math requirement will be waived based on satisfactory GMAT quantitative scores (30th percentile or better).

<sup>\*4</sup> A Maximum of 9 hours taken during the MST program in the "Business Education" category may also serve as Degree Requirements' Business Electives.

<sup>\*5</sup> A Maximum of 6 hours taken during the MST program in the "Accounting Education Beyond Principles" category may also serve as Degree Requirements' "Restricted" Accounting Electives. These hours must be graduate.

<sup>\*6</sup> MST students **cannot** enroll in Entities Taxation (ACCT 5340).
